ADVENT: A JOURNEY TOWARDS JESUS





Mary, queen of the Rosary Parish in the Archdiocese of Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania is the new parish entrusted to the Missionaries of St. Francis De Sales for pastoral care. The new parish was created by bifurcating an outstation from the Mary Mother of Mercy parish, Mji Mpya Relini. The outstation was made as a parish on 6th January, 2022. by Rt. Rev. Jude Thaddaeus Ruwa'ichi, O.F.M.Cap. the Archbishop of Dar es Salaam, and promulgated it as a parish on 8th August, 2022. The parish was officially inaugurated on 6th October 2022. Rt. Rev. Stephano Lameck Musomba, OSA, the Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Dar Es Salaam officiated at the Eucharistic celebration. Fr. Sheejan Kallarackal was officially installed as the Parish Priest of the new Parish. The occasion was graced by Rev. Fr. Mathew Thazhathukunnel, the provincial superior of the MSFS Province of East Africa, MSFS confreres and many priests and Religious from Morogoro and Dar es Salaam.





There are 43 small Christian communities within the parish, and has over 850 families. The Catholic community is active and vibrant despite their daily struggles and challenges. GOLDEN JUBILEE OF OSIA PARISH

St. Jude Catholic Parish, Osia, Uganda celebrated the Golden Jubilee of the establishment of the parish on November 13, 2022. Osia was a substation of Achilet Parish for half a century before its own formal beginnings as a parish in 1972. The first permanent church was built in 1944. The first parish priest of the newly formed parish of Osia was Fr. Vincent Castling MHM. But Fr. Leonard

Wiedemayer who succeeded Fr. Vincent can be called as the real founder of Osia parish because it was he who built all the permanent structures in Osia as well as its sub parishes.

Prior to the Golden jubilee celebrations, a solemn declaration of the jubilee was done on August 28, 2022 and a Jubilee cross was blessed on that day. The cross was taken to every Catholic family in the parish and approximately 4,156 families were visited and blessed by the priests during the period of the following two and a half months.

On the jubilee day all the faithful of the parish joined together for a procession from the main road to the parish church, which began at 9. 00 a.m.





At 10.30 a.m. the Archbishop of Tororo Most Rev. Dr. Emmanuel Obbo AJ, arrived at the parish and the Holy Mass began at 11.00 am. The parish choir, which was constituted exclusively for this function sang melodious hymns for the liturgy. The Archbishop confirmed 896 candidates and blessed the marriage of one couple during the Holy Mass. The King of Ateso tribe, the representative of the King of Adhola tribe, 4 members of the Parliament were among the many dignitaries present during the celebration. In spite of being a Sunday many priests and religious, together with many MSFS confreres were present for the Holy Mass and celebration. Rev. Fr. Robert Soosai Raj, the Mission Coordinator of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales in Uganda, represented Rev. Fr. Provincial Fr. Mathew Thazhathukunnel and conveyed the message from Fr. Provincial. The Holy Mass ended at 4.30 pm and thereafter all shared a fellowship meal.
