SILVER JUBILEE OF KENYA MISSION

"The Almighty has done great things for me and Holy is His name" (Lk 1:49). The life-giving presence and growth of the Church, in the modern world through various missionary Congregations proclaim the gracious presence of God amidst us. In the year 1997, MSFS accepted the invitation of the Bishop of the Diocese of Meru in Kenya and began its pastoral services in Chera Sub-station of Chuka parish. This Mission was elevated to be an independent parish in 1998 and thus it became the first mission of Fransalians in Kenya. Later, Fransalians' presence has been extended to other Dioceses in Kenya such as Machakos and Ngong. On January 7, 2023, with great jubilation and joy Fransalians and Christians of Chera parish gathered together to celebrate the silver jubilee of Fransalian presence in Kenya as well as that of the Chera Parish. The celebration began with the blessing of Jubilee memorial Grotto at Chera parish. Rt. Rev. Salesius Mugambi, the Bishop of Meru blessed the Grotto of Our Lady. The solemn Holy Eucharist was presided over by Bishop Salesius Mugambi. He thanked the Fransalians



for developing Chera Mission and for all the other ministries of Fransalians in Meru Diocese and in Kenya. The Parish choir, PMC and the youth made the occasion sweet by their melodious hymns during the Mass. The occasion was graced by the presence of the member of parliament for the area, chiefs, county leaders and several invited dignitaries. 

The annual meetings of the various Forums in the Province took place on February 01 and 02, 2023 at LCI.

Superiors' Forum Meeting: The forum discussed the Call of the General Chapter concerning consecrated life in community and its implementations at various levels in the province. The confreres are urged to live disciplined community life respecting one another and fulfilling our obligations as Religious. All the superiors are requested to conduct monthly community meetings to evaluate religious life, apostolic activities and to present financial report of the previous month. The forum discussed action plan of the Congress 2020 and the focus areas suggested by the General Curia and Provincial Curia in 2021. The forum also decided to deepen knowledge of Salesian spirituality at personal and community levels. Every community presented a report on community life and apostolic activities as well as the various challenges that they face in their ministry.

Mission Forum: The forum discussed matters concerning Mission from the Call of the General Chapter, the Action Plan of the Provincial Congress 2020 and Focus areas suggested by General and provincial curia for the year 2022-2023. It decided to intensify PMP in our parishes as well as to encourage starting of Fransalian Associates in every mission. The parish priests submitted reports regarding their respective parishes with the challenges that they face daily in their pastoral ministry. The forum suggested measures to deepen the faith of people by insisting on catechesis and sacramental life.

Education Forum: The forum made an evaluation of the implementation of Call of the General Chapter, action plan of the Provincial Congress 2020 and the focus areas suggested by General and Provincial Curia for 2022-2023. The forum insisted on imparting quality education in all our schools. The managers presented report from their respective schools.

Formation Forum: The forum discussed matters concerning Formation from the Call of the General Chapter, Action Plan of the Provincial Congress 2020 and Focus areas of General and provincial curia for the year 2022-2023. The forum discussed every stage of formation. It was decided to intensify vocation promotion from all three countries of East Africa. Although there are various challenges to vocation promotion, the forum upheld the present policy of vocation promotion. Reports were presented about every stage of formation. From this year, a programme in preparation for perpetual profession will be introduced for scholastics in Regency to third year of Theology.
