A New Mission of the MSFS in Eldoret, Kenya

We thank Rt. Rev. Dominic Kimongic of Eldoret for inviting us to the diocese of Eldoret. On January 22, 2025 accompanied by Fr. Antonysamy Sebastian, the coordinator of MSFS in Kenya, Fr. Sunny Vettickal and Fr. Innocent Ngowi Provincial Councillors, Fr. Japhet Kirimi and Fr. Provincial visited the centre called Kipkaren which is on the highway to Malaba, Uganda. Since the MSFS is working in the Archdiocese of Tororo, Uganda, the new centre is very strategically located. The auxiliary bishop of Eldoret Rt. Rev. John Kiplimo Lelei guided us to Kipkaren. We thank Fr. Peter Pinto SVD who accompanied us and who was instrumental in making our meeting with bishop of Eldoret possible.

In fact, Kipkaren is the substation from which the auxiliary bishop hails. The centre Kipkaren is right now under St. Mary, Queen of Peace parish, Osorongai in the diocese of Eldoret. This parish is run by Salvatorians. The parish borders with Bungoma and Kakamega dioceses. The parish church as well as the presbytery is located 3kms away from the highway. The MSFS is invited to take up Kipkaren and make it a parish. The assigned MSFS priest will stay in the presbytery of Osorongai parish along with the Salvatorians until a new presbytery is built in Kipkaren. It is then that an MSFS community can be established there.

Blessing of the Newly Renovated Novitiate House at Fransalianum, Bungo-Mkuza, Kibaha was done on the 1st of January. Fr. Provincial presided over the Eucharistic celebration. It was also the 25th anniversary of his ordination to priesthood.
